Neil Miner Award

Each year, the NAGT presents the Neil Miner Award to an individual for exceptional contributions to the stimulation of interest in the earth sciences. The Award, presented each year since 1953, commemorates Neil Miner's concern for personal excellence and effective teaching. His ideals, his notably unselfish outlook on life, and his personal philosophy inspired his fellow teachers as well as his students.

To Make a Nomination

Anyone may make a nomination. The nominator must submit **only** the following. Please do not include additional materials:

1. a letter of nomination stating why the nominee is an outstanding geoscience teacher.
2. up to a maximum of ten letters of support from colleagues and former students. At least five of these letters must be written by former students, and all letters must be written specifically for the Neil Miner Award nomination.
3. the nominee's *curriculum vitae*.
