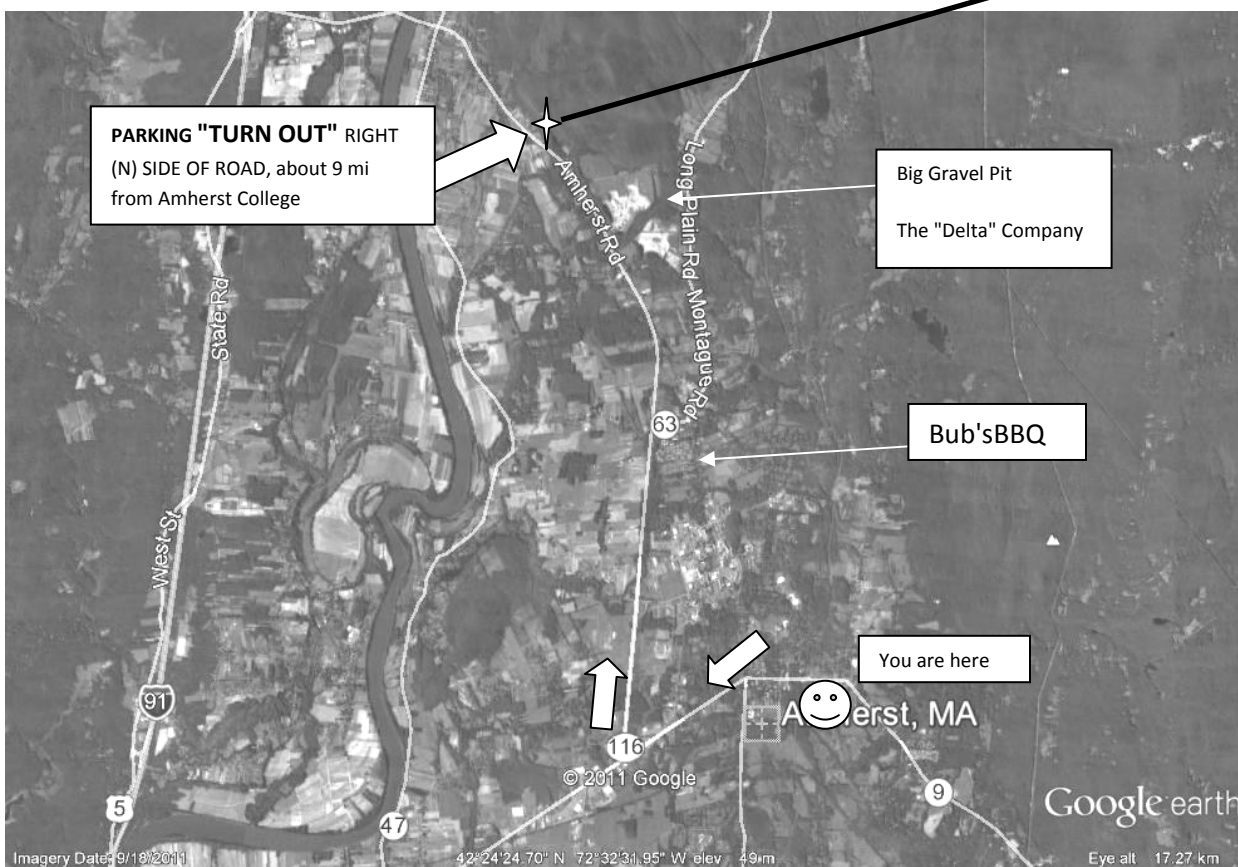

Field Trip Map. We will start at the "Turn Out"



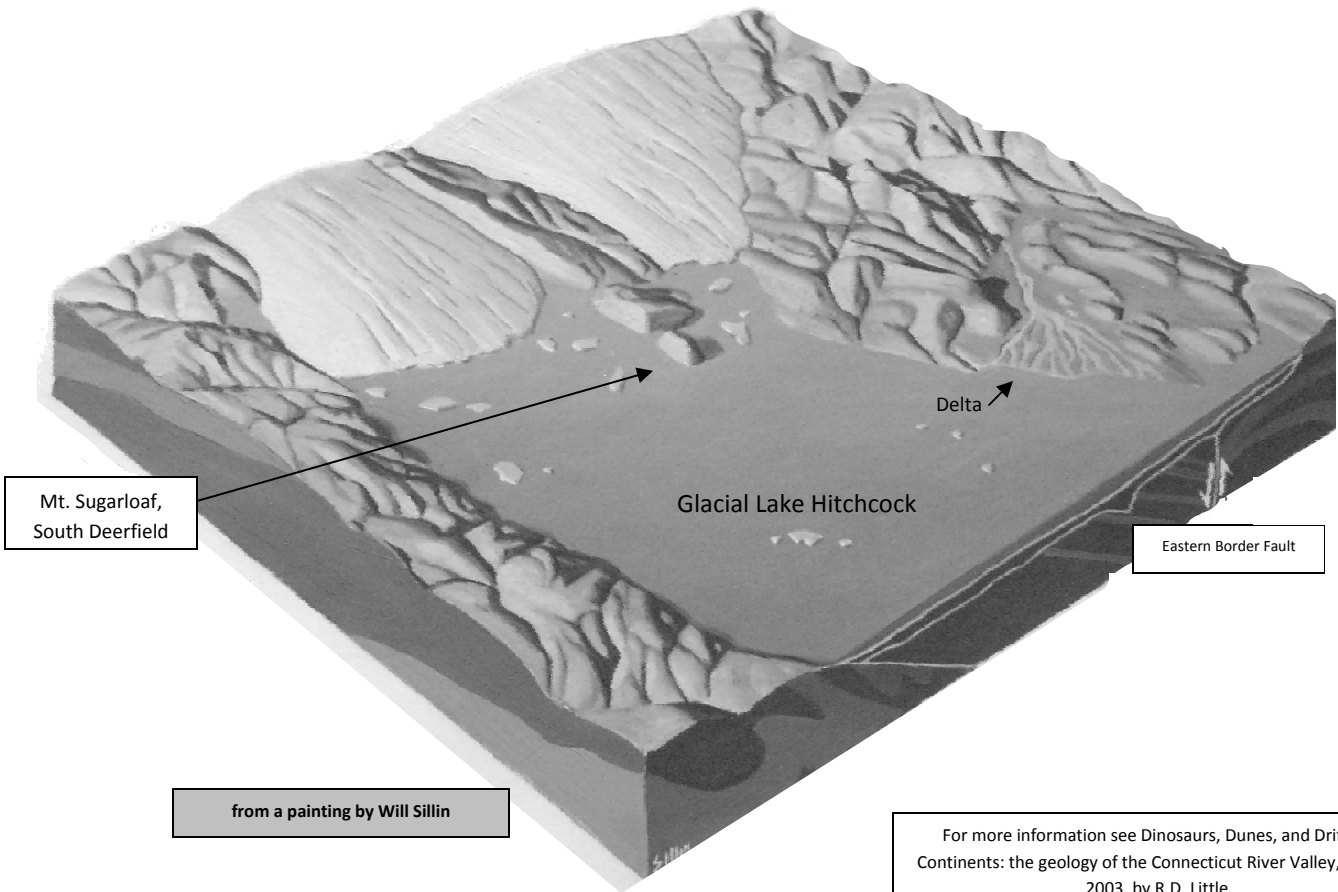
